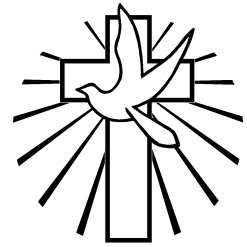

Main points of the PCC meeting held on
Sunday 26 April 2015

Here is the usual summary of the PCC's short meeting held shortly after the morning's Annual Church Meeting. This was mainly to deal with essential housekeeping matters at the beginning of the new PCC's year. As always, full details are in the displayed draft minutes.

Composition: We began by noting the PCC's composition for 2015-16, as below, with a particular welcome for those (marked by an asterisk) elected and re-elected at the Annual Church Meeting.

- **Clergy:** the Revds Rosemary Donovan; Julian McAllen; and Sue Curtis;
- **Churchwardens:** Robert Burns* & Carol Jamieson*;
- **Deanery Synod members:** Berwick Curtis, Leslie Jamieson, Jenny Power plus a vacancy which the PCC will seek to fill; and
- **Elected PCC members:** Denise Chamberlain; Alan Frame*; Gill Glasspool; Lucy Healy, Ruth Grint*; Richard Martin*; Sue Matthews; Roger Morgan; June Skinner; Ro Stretton, Anne Sturton*; & John Tregoning.

Appointments: Among the various annual appointments were: Roger Morgan as PCC Secretary; Alan Frame as Treasurer; Malcolm Channing as Assistant Treasurer; Martin Shipton as Electoral Roll Officer; and the following Committees.

- **Business & Resources Committee** (being, with slight enhancement, the required "Standing Committee"), chaired by the Vicar;
- **Finance Group**, chaired by June Skinner;
- **Premises Group**, chaired by Jim Smith; and
- **Missions Group**, chaired by Anne Sturton.

We also appointed Val Flick and Ros Lee as additional Assistants at Communion, mainly for service at Christ Church on the Wells.

Little Hands Nursery: We noted the good progress being made on the possibility of being able to accommodate the Little Hands Nursery when it has to leave the Scout HQ in September – and particularly welcome the willingness of Little Hands and Wheels & Squeals to find a means of co-existing in the Hall. However, much remains to be done and urgent work continues.

Other Business: Recalling Merinda D'Aprano's thoughtful sermon at the Mothering Sunday Choral Evensong, we agreed to fund her attendance on a course for "Occasional Preachers".

Future meetings: PCC meetings for the remainder of 2015-16 will be held on: 15 June, 14 September, 9 November, 11 January and 14 March – all Mondays at 8pm in the Hall. (Other meetings may, of course, be arranged as necessary.)
