



## **Christ Church Missions Group – ‘Refreshing’ our Champions Applications invited**

Last month the Missions Group gave some background on the way Mission Champions work in Christ Church. We advised that, following a three year ‘tenure’, it is time to review our arrangements and either renew our giving to the nine missions we support at present, or introduce new ones, to replace those which may no longer need help so much.

### **Missions we support**

The Missions Group reports to the PCC which suggests that Missions supported should:

- be recognisably Christian
- preferably have a clear identifiable project which we can learn about and follow
- have an identifiable Mission Partner whom we can support in prayer and with whom we can liaise
- be engaged in a relationship with those they are trying to help
- be a continuing project

### **Being a Missions Champion**

If you support or are closely involved with a mission which you think might be suitable, this is what is involved:

- The Champions are the link between Christ Church and the Mission Partner.
- They keep in touch with the named Mission Partner, and keep Christ Church informed via:
  - notes on the Missions Notice Board
  - talking to the congregation
  - arranging small exhibitions
  - arranging for the Mission Partner to visit from time to time
