### Greeting

The Lord be with you **and also with you**

*(Church lights dimmed)*

### Confession

Light shows up things that have been forgotten or lost or hidden. As we come into Jesus' presence, his light reminds us of all the good things we have forgotten to do and all the things we have hidden away. But if we say sorry, then we can walk in the light.

As we sit in the darkness we remember
